Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

Welcome to the 2019-20 school year! I am excited to begin the new year and to welcome each student back to Harrison High School. It is my privilege to lead the team of professionals who will educate your children during the coming school year as our core values of equity, access, rigor and adaptability do not simply exist on paper, but come alive in the actions of our faculty and staff. Every member of the Harrison High School community is committed to supporting your child's success with opportunities to explore, to be challenged and to flourish throughout the coming year.

We have had an active and productive summer at Harrison High School. Students attended summer programs, including: Writers Workshop, College Essay Writing, Extended Essay Research, AP World Institute, and IB Diploma Candidate Orientation. Many members of our faculty and administration have participated in and led professional training throughout the summer, and we are prepared to begin another productive school year.

We are eager to continue implementation of the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Program (MYP). Harrison High School and LMK launched this curriculum change last year, which provides all students in grades six through 10 with the foundational characteristics of an IB Learner: *Principled, Inquirers, Knowledgeable, Thinkers, Communicators, Open-Minded, Caring, Risk-Takers, Balanced, and Reflective*. We believe that these attributes are aligned with the district's core values and support our commitment to an inclusive, student-centered learning experience while further supporting The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program Courses for students in grades 11 and 12.

We believe parents are important partners in a student's educational experience and encourage you to be involved and to attend your child's activities as often as you are able. #### Student Emergency Contact Information:

In the near future, you receive directions from the Chief Information Officer, Brian Seligman, on how to update your demographic information and emergency contacts through the Parent Portal. Please take a moment and check it for accuracy. If there are any changes needed, please follow the directions you receive to make the changes in the Portal.

#### Student Schedules:

Schedules will be available through the Portal beginning on August 30<sup>th</sup>. We make every effort to fulfill each student's individual course enrollment requests. Student requests are fulfilled based upon course availability, teacher and student schedules, and other considerations, such as room availability. In the event of insufficient or over enrollment, some elective courses may be combined or altered. In cases of elective over enrollment, grade level seniority is considered.

### Transcripts [for seniors only]:

Transcripts (for seniors only) will be mailed to the address on file along with a "Student Transcript Explanation" letter. Please review carefully. If there are any questions, please contact your child's counselor at 914-630-3101 as soon as possible. Parents and students are asked to sign and return transcripts to the Main Office. Underclassmen will receive their transcripts at a later date.

Student Email is available for all high school students. We utilize student email to communicate in a timely fashion important information to students. Students should check their accounts daily.

Please see your school counselor should you require financial assistance. In addition, we are a "BYOD" (Bring Your Own Device) high school. Students will need to have a Chromebook or laptop with them each day as devices are often used to enhance classroom instruction. Chromebooks are available in the library for students to sign-out for a full day, a few weeks, or an entire school year depending on their circumstances.

Seniors on free and reduced lunch have their fees waved automatically for the following expenses: Senior portrait sitting fee, senior year yearbook, prom (ticket for student only), graduation cap & gown fee.

Yearbook picture dates for underclassmen are being taken in Physical Education classes on *Thursday, September 5th and Friday, September 6th* in the small gymnasium. Retakes will be made in the HPAC on Friday, October 18<sup>th</sup>. Lifetouch Studios is in the process of mailing information directly to parents about the procedures to be used, should parents wish to purchase pictures.

#### Locker Combinations:

Locker numbers and combinations will be emailed to students at their Harrison Gmail address. Students are encouraged to not share their locker combinations.

#### Senior Parking:

Senior Parking is now completed through a new online enrollment system available at <u>https://form.jotform.com/82004208863149</u> Clicking on the link will take you to the form you must complete in order to start the process. Once the form is complete and submitted online, your parent/guardian will receive an email with further directions and finalization steps to the online process. *There is a mandatory meeting after school on September 5th in the HPAC for all seniors seeking campus parking.* Those who have successfully completed the online process will receive their parking passes at the meeting. On the first day of school, you will be given a grace day to park on campus without displaying a parking tag. *Leave privileges will begin on Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup>*. Regrettably, there is only enough room for parking for seniors who would like to drive to school.

### Leave Campus Privileges:

All seniors and juniors who are in good standing and have parental and administrative approval may leave campus during their lunch. Seniors may also leave during their free periods. Information was recently emailed pertaining to juniors who want permission to leave the campus during their lunch period using our new online enrollment system available at

Once the form is complete and submitted online, the parent/guardian will receive an email with further directions and finalization steps to the online process. Those who have successfully completed the online process will be permitted to leave campus beginning on Friday, September 6th. Sophomores and freshman may not leave the campus during school hours. Please note, students who have any obligations to the school will not be able to leave campus until that obligation is rectified. No one may leave campus on foot during the school day unless leaving for the day.
