admissions process as some colleges use these exams to measure college readiness and predict future academic success.

Ordering information for each of the exams is listed below. Each student's exam will be ordered upon collection of payment. No refunds will be issued if your child decides to not sit for the exam after the order has been placed. - The ACT will be offered with Writing. Students may elect not to sit for the writing portion of the exam. Students must make this decision at the time of registration and no changes may be made once registered. The cost of the exam is \$65. Cash or check are acceptable forms of payment and checks should be made payable to Harrison Central School District. Students who qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch may submit the registration form without payment. Payment and the attached paper registration form (also available in Guidance) must be submitted to the Guidance Office by the end of the school day on Friday, January 6, 2023. No late registrations will be accepted.
- The cost of the SAT exam is \$60. Cash or check are acceptable forms of payment and checks should be made payable to Harrison Central School District. Students who qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch may submit the registration form without payment. Payment and the attached paper registration form (also available in Guidance) must be submitted to the Guidance Office by the end of the school day on Friday, January 6, 2023. No late registrations will be accepted.
