<u>The 6th Annual Lifting Up Westchester Student Essay Contest</u> is open to all Westchester students in grades 7 through 12. The topic this year is: "**The Importance of Good Mental Health**". Submissions must be made between November 3, 2022, and February 17, 2023. Winners will be announced March 13, 2023.

Following is some information about the essays:

- The essays must be between 750 and 1000 words.
- Essays should address the effects of mental health, whether good or poor, upon the choices we make, our relationships, our families, our education, our daily lives, and our futures.
- Particular emphasis should be given to the mental health challenges that homeless individuals face.
- We encourage essayists to include a lyric, a stanza from a poem, or a quote from a book that is relevant to mental health or related issues. While this will not be included in the overall word count, it will add significantly to the student's essay.
- Prizes will be awarded in three grade categories: 7-8, 9-10, and 11-12 and in a category created specifically for ESL students.
